

Privacy Policy

1. General information

1. This Privacy Policy sets out the rules for the processing of personal data and the use of cookies and similar technologies in connection with the use of the website available at www.ctpevents.pl and its subpages and subdomains (the "Website").
2. The administrator of personal data is CTP Invest Poland Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością, Chmielna 69, 00-801 Warsaw (the "Administrator").
3. Contact with the Administrator is possible by e-mail at: kontakt@ctpevents.pl.

2. Scope and purposes of personal data processing

The Administrator processes personal data only to the extent necessary for the functioning of the Website, contact services, marketing activities and ensuring the security and proper operation of the Website.

2.1. Contact form

1. If you use the contact form, the following data may be processed:
 - Name and surname,
 - Email address
 - Phone number
 - Company name,
 - Date of birth
2. The data is processed:
 - to enable registration for the event,
 - to protect against potential claims and to demonstrate the correct handling of the registration process.
3. The legal basis for the processing is:
 - the need to take actions related to registration for the event and related to the conclusion of a contract for the provision of services by electronic means,
 - the Administrator's legitimate interest in communication, handling inquiries and ensuring the security and proper operation of the Website.
4. Providing data is voluntary, but necessary for proper registration for the event.

2.2. Marketing and marketing communication

1. In the case of a separate consent, the Administrator may process the user's data for the purpose of:
 - sending commercial and marketing information electronically,
 - conducting telephone contact regarding the Administrator's services or offer.
2. Consent may be withdrawn at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the previous processing.

2.3. Technical data and server logs

1. When using the Website, technical data concerning the user and their device may be automatically collected, in particular:
 - IP address,

- date and time of visit,
 - information about the browser and operating system,
 - Device information
 - Request URL
 - information about technical errors.
2. This data is stored in the server logs and is used for the following purposes:
 - ensuring the security of the Website,
 - technical diagnostics,
 - fraud detection,
 - ensure the proper functioning of the Website.
 3. The data are processed on the basis of the legitimate interest of the Administrator, which consists in ensuring the security of the Website, its proper operation and the possibility of detecting and counteracting abuse.

3. Cookies and similar technologies

1. The Website uses cookies to ensure the proper functioning of the Website.
2. Cookies are small text files that are stored on the user's end device when using the Website.
3. The following types of cookies may be used on the Website:
 - necessary – required for the proper functioning of the Site, ensuring its security and using the basic functions of the Site;
 - functional – aimed at improving the convenience of using the Website.
4. Necessary cookies are used on the basis of the Administrator's legitimate interest in ensuring the security and proper operation of the Website.
5. You may at any time:
 - change cookie settings,
 - block cookies in your web browser settings.
6. Restricting the use of cookies may affect selected functionalities of the Website.

4. Data recipients

1. Personal data may be transferred to entities supporting the Administrator in operating the Website and conducting business, including:
 - hosting providers,
 - IT and technical support providers,
 - Live Age event agency, providing support in the process of registering participants and conducting the event
2. The data is transferred only to the extent necessary to achieve the indicated purposes.

5. Transfer of data outside the European Economic Area

1. Data may be transferred outside the European Economic Area, in particular to the United States.
2. This applies in particular to data processed as part of:
 - analytical and marketing tools,
 - services related to the maintenance of IT infrastructure, e-mail or data backup.
3. If data is transferred to a country for which the European Commission has issued an adequacy decision, the transfer is based on that decision.
4. If the data is transferred to a country for which no decision has been issued stating an adequate level of data protection, the Controller applies appropriate safeguards provided for in the GDPR, in particular standard contractual clauses adopted by the European Commission.

5. The User may obtain a copy of the security measures applied regarding the transfer of data outside the European Economic Area or information about the place where they are made available by contacting the Administrator via the form available on the Website.

6. Data retention period

1. Personal data are stored for the period necessary to achieve the purpose of processing, in particular:
 - data related to the contact form – for the period of registration, and then for the period necessary to protect against potential claims and demonstrate the correct handling of the registration process,
 - data processed on the basis of marketing consent – until the consent is withdrawn,
 - Technical data and server logs – for the period resulting from current security and diagnostic needs,
 - data related to cookies – according to the period of storage of individual cookies or until they are deleted by the user.

7. Rights of data subjects

1. The data subject has the right to:
 - access to data,
 - rectification of data,
 - delete data,
 - restriction of processing,
 - data portability,
 - object to processing,
 - withdraw consent at any time,

3. Each person whose data is processed by the Administrator has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (uodo.gov.pl).

8. Automated decision-making

1. Your personal data is not used to make automated decisions that produce legal effects on you or similarly significantly affect you.
2. In connection with the use of analytical and marketing tools, the Administrator may carry out activities consisting in adjusting advertising content or analyzing user activity, but these activities do not cause legal effects on the user or significantly affect him.

9. Changes to the Privacy Policy

1. The Administrator may update this Privacy Policy in the event of legal, technological or organizational changes.
2. The current version of the Policy is published on the Website.
